Safeguarding God's Children & Background Checks

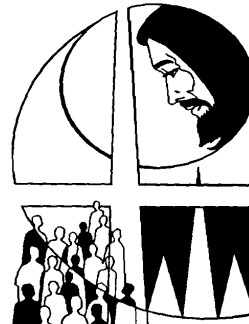
